Waterside Café/ Restaurant



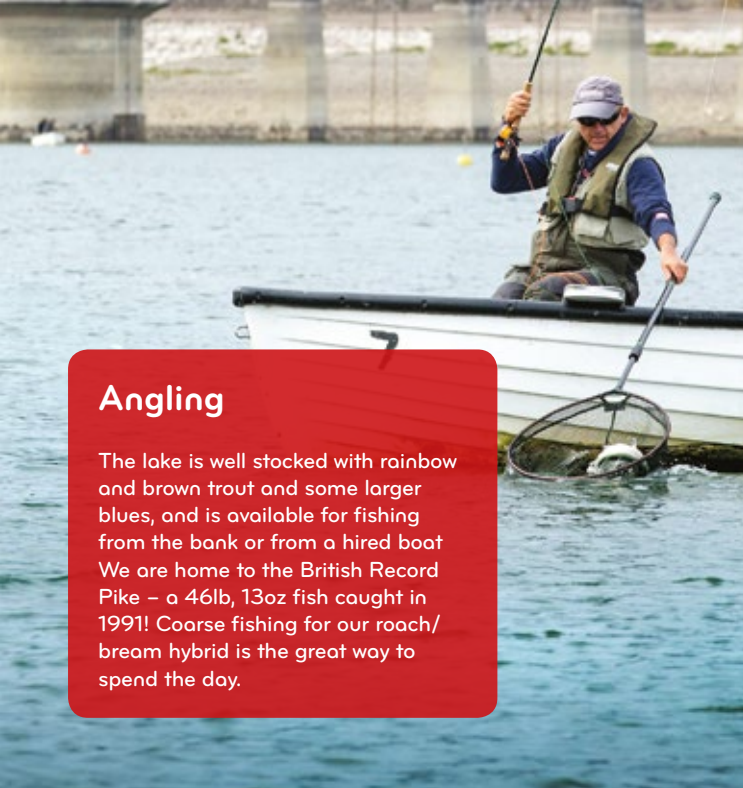

Angling

The lake is well stocked with rainbow and brown trout and some larger blues, and is available for fishing from the bank or from a hired boat. We are home to the British Record Pike – a 46lb, 13oz fish caught in 1991! Coarse fishing for our roach/bream hybrid is the great way to spend the day.



Walking

From March to Oct we have over 6 miles of footpaths and way-marked walks for you to explore. Something for everyone from a gentle stroll through the fields to a hike around the reservoir and surrounding area.



Bird Watching

Designated a SSSI for its importance to large numbers of over-wintering wildfowl. Llandegfedd is one of the major sites for birds in Wales with over 240 species recorded. Gulls, breeding birds and passage migrants can be seen during spring and autumn.

Sail Sports

Paddle Sports

Paddling provides a different perspective and at Llandegfedd we have amazing views for you to see from the reservoir. We can get you onto the water with taster sessions and beginner course through to courses suitable for prospective instructors.

Children Holiday Activities

9am to 5pm

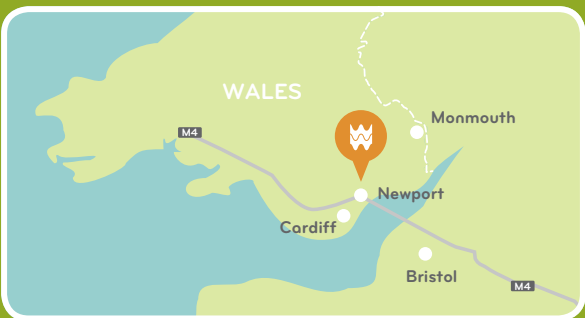
